ANDREW MENTIS FUND:



At our Monthly Game in Oudtshoorn the AMNF Committee (representing the [Southern Cape Nomads](#)) had the privilege of handing over an amount of R170 000 towards [Eljada Nasorgsentrum](#), our beneficiary for the Andrew Mentis fund for this year. We then also attended the Miss South Africa visit to Eljada on Saturday 21 September with the official handover planned at Eljada. The money will be used to acquire much needed medical equipment, maintenance and items to lower their monthly expenses and a project for them to generate an income.

Eljada is a registered residential care facility to provide full-time care for one hundred adults with intellectual disabilities. They offer a holistic development and care program where they receive loving care and support and also accommodate day care clients who live in the community during weekdays.

Service delivery at Eljada Care focuses on promoting and maintaining the full potential of persons with intellectual disabilities. They strive to provide support so that clients can be independent and full members of the community. It is therefore important that they remain an integral part of the community. Learning manual skills is an essential part of the Development Programme. The live-in/day care clients can thereby exercise their creativity and be intellectually stimulated and at the same time their self-esteem is improved. Eljada Care is a dormitory-type facility, located in Upper Victoria Street on the North-East side of Oudtshoorn. They are approximately 4km from the town center and festival grounds.

Eljada Care is a program of the larger Badisa group. They are a registered, non-profit organization, as well as a Public Welfare Organization (PBO 930 006 348).

ABOUT ANDREW MENTIS FUND:

HISTORY

Traditionally, Andrew Mentis in his personal capacity, made an annual donation to each South African Nomads Club to assist them with their charity fund raising efforts. At the turn of this century the Nomads Golf Club South Africa was informed that Andrew Mentis was to bequest a sum of money to the National Executive so as to continue this tradition in perpetuity.

One of the most important objectives and raison d'être associated with Nomads Golf is the collective spirit displayed by all Club Members towards raising funds for charitable purposes and for recognising "those less fortunate than ourselves".

In line with this the Andrew Mentis Nomads Foundation was created to channel the funds generated for distribution to worthwhile causes on a project-by-project basis. It is important to understand that all Nomads' fund-raising activities are directed at specific projects and programmes – no monies are allocated to supporting the running of organisations or for their costs associated with general administration.

The initiative was given impetus by Andrew Mentis, a Nomad Founder Member in 1967 in Gauteng and he still contributes personally to the fund every year. Each member club forms an Andrew Mentis sub-committee, which is chaired by the Vice Captain of the club and is specifically tasked to co-ordinate activities aimed at raising funds for the foundation. Monies raised are donated to a pre-selected charity that operates within each Club's own geographical area in the form of tangible asset upon which the Nomads emblem is displayed.

Each year every Club's activities culminate with the handover of the asset to the selected Charity at the annual Andrew Mentis golf day which is also open to the public by invitation. This gives invited guests, including women and juniors an opportunity to experience the Nomadic camaraderie and purpose at its finest. Nationally, since inception, the Andrew Mentis Endowment Fund has raised and donated about R 50 million to charities.

Getting involved in the annual Andrew Mentis drive for funds is a basic Nomadic responsibility, one which each Nomad takes on with pride.
