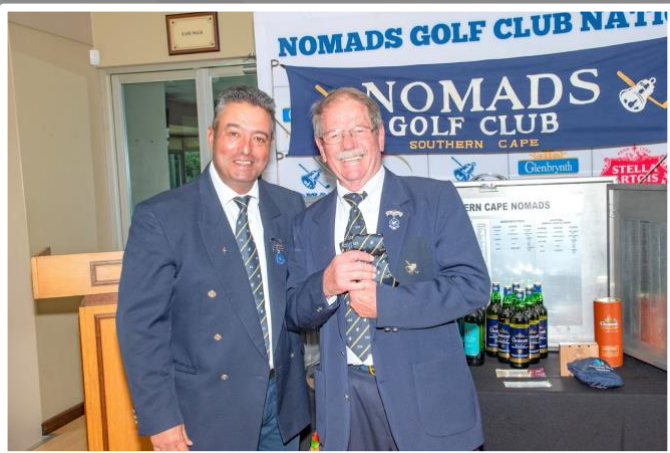

## Golforama Newsletter for December 2023

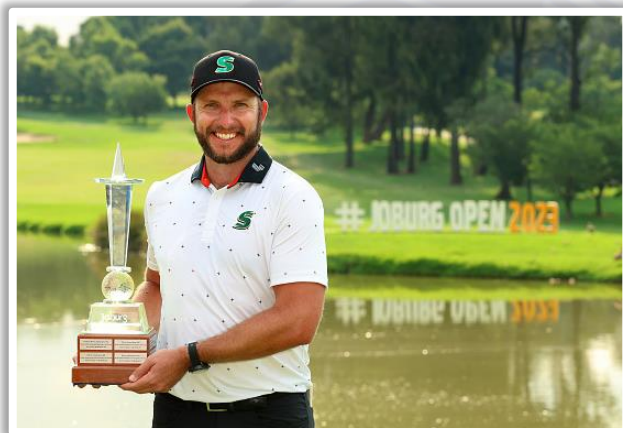
### As reported last month, these tournaments were played in November:

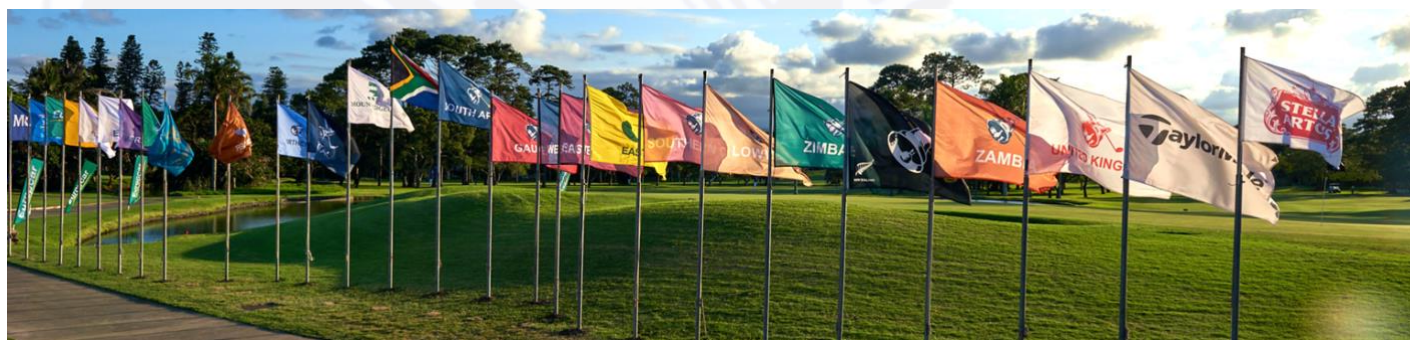

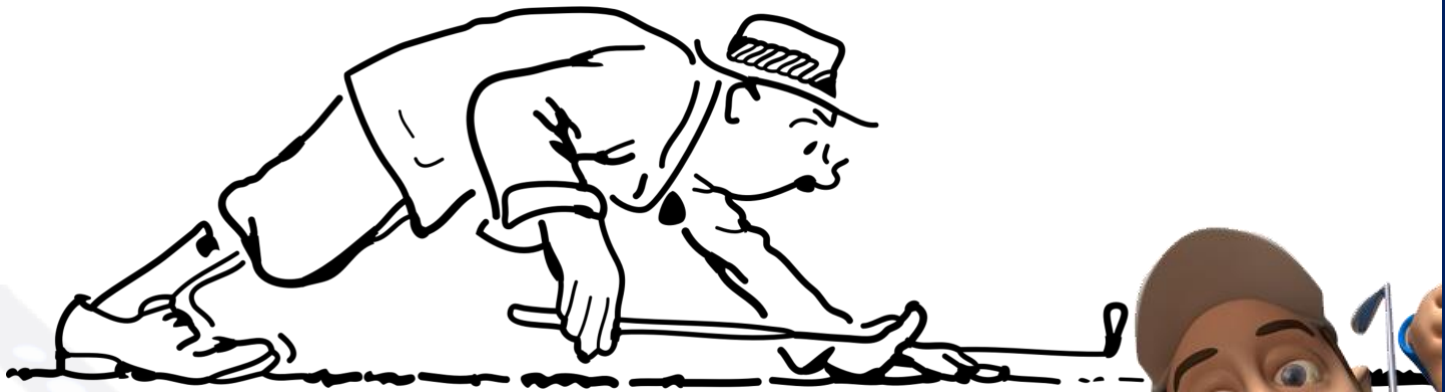
